## Using keywords

## Refining

### Refining keywords for better search results

If you can't find what you are looking for, try refining your search. Use other keywords and be specific. If you are looking for information about how to care for angora rabbits make sure to use keywords like angora rabbit care, angora rabbit maintenance, angora rabbit health

## Using synonyms

### Use the correct language when searching

What do panda's eat?  
panda diet  
How long do panda's live for?  
panda life expectancy

## Get the right reading level for you

### Use for kids or for students when searching

What is pollination?  
Pollination for kids  
You can change the reading level of text in the search tool

## Check the site authenticity

### [www.readtheurl.com.au](http://www.readtheurl.com.au) before clicking

Read the site URL or address to deem whether the site is home made, authentic Government or credible. An address can say a lot about the site's information and validity

## Open search results in multiple tabs

### Scan the text, dismiss if irrelevant

Scan the search results, click and open sites in multiple tabs. Never click on a search result from the tab you are currently looking at. This is inefficient and will slow you down. Quickly scan the text for relevant information and dismiss tabs that are not helpful.

## Expand your search

### Use a variety of text

Sometimes it is easier to find information via videos, images, digraphs and infographics. Use the images and videos tab or type in life cycle diagram, pollution infographic
